

JOE MACRAE MEMORIAL FALL SERIES 2023 FOR AGED HORSES & MARES

For HORSES AND MARES AGED 5 AND OVER, WHO ARE NON-WINNERS OF \$4500 IN 2023, and who have raced a MINIMUM OF twelve (12) starts ON PEI in 2023.

To be raced at Red Shores at the Charlottetown Driving Park.

DECLARATION DATE Wednesday, November 1st by 9:00 am.

NO NOMINATION OR STARTING FEE

In the event there is enough entries to fill both a horse/ gelding and mares event, entries will be separated by sex.

Elimination(s)	Sunday, November 5, 2023	\$3,000
Consolation	Sunday, November 12th, 2023	\$3,200
Final	Sunday, November 12th, 2023	\$4,500

1. DECLARATION DUE BY Wednesday, November 1st at 9:00 am. Those DECLARING horses to these events are responsible for eligibility.
2. Declarations close at the time and date posted on the weekly condition sheet. ELIGIBILITY DETERMINED BY STARTS AND MONEY EARNINGS AS OF Tuesday, October 31st.
3. NO nomination and starting fees.
4. A minimum of Eight (8) DECLARATIONS ARE Required to fill this EVENT. If less than 8 DECLARATIONS are received the event may proceed at the discretion of Red Shores.
5. Horses not earning purses money in the Elimination(s) will receive a \$75 Hook up fee.
6. The Final will race a distance of a mile with a field of up to eight (8) starters. The field for the Final will be determined by the money earnings in the Division(s).
7. Horses finishing 6th to last in the FINAL WILL RECEIVE A \$150 HOOK UP FEE. Horses finishing 6th to last in the CONSOLATION WILL RECEIVE A \$100 HOOK UP FEE.
8. In the event that there is a consolation, horses that earn enough money in the series to qualify for the final cannot race in the consolation.
9. In the event there is enough entries to fill both a horse/gelding and mares event, entries will be separated by sex. Otherwise, horses, geldings, and mares will race together.
10. In the event of a tie, the entry will be selected by lot.
11. All races will be at a distance of 1 mile unless otherwise stated.
12. Post positions for all events will be drawn by the Standardbred Canada Electronic Draw.
13. All events and race conditions will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission and Standardbred Canada.
14. Red Shores reserves the right to rearrange programs and in the event that on the day of the scheduled race, the operation of races cannot be held for any reason whatsoever, they reserve the right to reschedule the race to an APHRC approved future race date. Red Shores accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, loss, or damage, which may occur on their property as a result of these, or any races.
15. All owners, trainers, drivers must be members in good standing with the APHRC and Standardbred Canada.
16. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Red Shores.
17. In the consolation or final, should there be horses with common ownership; Red Shores reserves the right to uncouple horses for pari-mutuel purposes as per APHRC Rule 206.

18. If there is more than one division of the preliminary event, each division will race for 100% of the advertised purse.

19. Purse distribution:

- a. 5 or more starters: 50 — 25 — 12 — 8 — 5%.
- b. 4 starters: 50 — 25 — 15 — 10%.
- c. 3 starters: 60 — 30 — 10%.
- d. 2 starters: 65 — 35%.
- e. 1 starter: 100%.
