Grassroots Division: For non winners of \$60,000 life as of Dec. 31st, 2024, that are four, five, and six years of age and are Maritime Foaled and/or Maritime Sired. **A trainer may race a grassroots eligible horse in the Gold Division at their discretion.**

Nomination Fees: \$100 For Gold Series and \$50 for Grassroot Series due May 21st, 2025 by 9:00 a.m. at the Charlottetown Race Office. Cash or cheque accepted as forms of payment. Cheques made payable to Red Shores.

Conditions:

1. All events and race conditions will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission and Standardbred Canada.
2. Declarations close at the time and date posted on the weekly condition sheet.
3. All races will be at a distance of 1 mile unless otherwise stated.
4. All starting positions shall be drawn electronically using the electronic draw system provided by Standardbred Canada
5. Purse distribution:
 - a. 5 or more starters: 50 — 25 — 12 — 8 — 5%;
 - b. 4 starters: 50 — 25 — 15 — 10%;
 - c. 3 starters: 60 — 30 — 10%;
 - d. 2 starters: 65 — 35%;
 - e. 1 starter: 100%.
6. A minimum of six (6) entries for each sex are required to fill each division.
If the minimum amount of entries per sex is not achieved, then that division will not go and the nominating fees for that division will be refunded.
7. If there is more than one division of the preliminary legs or eliminations, each division will race for 100% of the advertised purse.
8. Finalists will be determined by money earned in preliminary legs. The top nine (9) money earners from the legs will race in the Final. In the event of a tie, the entry will be selected by lot.
9. All nominating fees will be added to the purses.
10. Red Shores reserves the right to make any changes to conditions and schedule they deem fit.
11. All owners, trainers, drivers must be members in good standing with the APHRC and Standardbred Canada.
12. All horses must meet the qualifying standards of Red Shores and the Atlantic Standardbred Breeders Association.
13. Should there be horses with common ownership; Red Shores reserves the right to uncouple horses for pari-mutuel purposes as per APHRC Rule 206.
14. Red Shores accepts no responsibility or liability for any accident, loss, or damage, which may occur on their property as a result of these, or any races.
